### Eligibility Criteria

Candidates who meet the following criteria will be prioritized:

- County Government employees within the Republic of Kenya
- Work experience of at least two years at a county health facility (CRH or SCRH)
- Registered with the respective regulatory body for the basic training
- Secured approval and release by the county

### Selection Process

Each candidate must go through the following process to be awarded a scholarship:

- Reauthorization by the employer during the application
- Shortlisting and interviewing by the training institution
- Selection by the AT program scholarships selection committee
- Admission by the training institution
- Release and bonding by the employer as per the public service commission guidelines
- Enrollment by the training institution

### Scholarship package

The scholarship caters for the following during the study period: **Tuition Fee and Stipend**

To qualify, you will need to apply separately or the training program directly to KMTc. To be awarded a scholarship, you must get an 'unconditional offer for one of your course choices. To apply for these training programs, interested applicants should visit the KMTc application portal for detailed information about the training programs.
