Procurement in KMTC

Kenya Medical Training College conducts procurement of goods, works or services. The procurement is geared towards addressing the national (Big four agenda and specifically the Universal Health Coverage (UHC) being a key pillar).

In this regard, KMTC of which has a total of 82 campuses applies both the centralized and decentralized forms of procurement. All procurement spends which is 500,000/= and above is handled at either level though the final awarding is done centrally at the KMTC headquarters by the Chief Executive Officer.

The campuses are mandated to award procurements whose respective value do not exceed Kshs. 500,000/=.
